On August 11, 12, & 13, artists will gather along the Chattahoochee River at Island Ford, Azalea Drive, Vickery Creek, and Willeo Park to create beautiful works of art inspired by the great Chattahoochee River. What a wonderful time to enjoy the beauty of the Chattahoochee while also celebrating the visual arts created by artists working with acrylics, oils, pastels and watercolors.

The public is invited to meet the artists and watch them work and perhaps find a work of art they just can't resist, one they have watched being created from conception to finish. The artists will select up to two pieces of work, created on site August 11 – 13, to exhibit at the special reception on August 14th. The reception will be held from 7:30 – 9:30 P.M. at the Island Ford Headquarters of the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area.

The Great Chattahoochee River Paint-Out is a competition as the artists will compete for monetary and other awards in recognition of their work.

The First Great Chattahoochee River Paint-Out was the inspiration of Roswell artist Joan Hilliard who wanted to share the beauty of Roswell and the Chattahoochee River with fellow artists from across the U.S.

Hosted by the Roswell Convention & Visitors Bureau and the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area, last year's event was a tremendous success and there has been overwhelming support of it as an annual event. Roswell is well known for arts festivals and cultural events. The Great Chattahoochee River Paint-Out is a very different, and yet complimentary event, to make the Roswell art scene even more enjoyable.
